"Draw Me Nearer, Blessed Lord Dana Mengel

Lyrics by Fanny J. Crosby (1820-1915)

I am thine, O Lord, I have heard thy voice, and it told thy love to me; But I long to rise in the arms of faith and be closer drawn to thee.

Refrain: Draw me nearer, blessed Lord, to the cross where thou hast died.

Draw me nearer, blessed Lord, to thy precious bleeding side.

Consecrate me now to thy service, Lord, by the pow'r of grace divine; Let my soul look up with a steadfast hope, and my will be lost in thine.

O the pure delight of a single hour that before thy throne I spend, When I kneel in prayer, and with thee my God, I commune as friend with friend.

The lyrics of this anthem are deeply familiar to most Protestant Christans. Fanny J. Crosby was a prolific hymnwriter, publishing over eight thousand hymns and gospel songs. She was called the "Queen of Gospel Songwriters" and "Mother of modern congregational singing in America." She also published over a thousand poems in four volumes, along with two autobiographies. Fanny was blind since early infancy, and her condition certainly inspired much of her writing. Her blindness also opened the door to an exceedingly wonderful education for a woman of her time at the New York Institute for the Blind. Fanny's life was full of accomplishments – notably she was the first woman to speak in the US Senate in 1843 when she recited a poem there in support of publicly funded education for the blind. She was remembered as an overly generous woman, giving away anything not absolutely needed for daily life. "Let my soul look up with a steadfast hope, and my will be lost in Thine," – what a beautiful prayer to recite throughout the week. May we recognize the endless hope we have in Christ and seek God's will continuously.
