She wrote many hymns during her short life, resulting in two published hymnals (one released posthumously). Unfortunately, Sylvia succumbed to liver cancer at the age of thirty-eight. She left behind a legacy of compassion for those in need and an overwhelming love for liturgy. The lyrics of this hymn were inspired by the line in the Lord's prayer, "Thy kingdom come," and the 126th Psalm.

This arrangement was done by an imminently talented living American composer ,Evelyn Simpson-Curenton. Simpson is a native of Philadelphia and an alumna of Temple University.
