About the Anthem:

Mark Hayes is considered one of the foremost composers, arrangers, and orchestrators in the world. He began studying piano at the age of ten and went on to graduate from Baylor University in Texas. Afterwards he set out composing and has published over 1,500 pieces of music. Mr. Hayes has traveled the world serving as a guest conductor, director of musical theatre productions, orchestrator, pianist, and clinician. Creating beautiful music is his self-described mission and calling. There are far too many lyrics in the five songs above to print all of them here. However, most of us know at least a couple of these well enough to sing or hum along. While all these songs reference eternal life in heaven, they also remind us that we each are part of the communion of saints. We are brothers and sisters in Christ; together we carry out His ministry and Great Commission throughout the world.
